

Dual Credit: College courses taught at the high school by CEI approved instructors or through IDLA.

Concurrent Enrollment: Courses taken on a CEI campus or via CEI online

CEI Early College Programs offers high school students the opportunity to take college courses at a reduced rate. Courses are available at local high schools, online or on the CEI campus. Early College students must meet general edibility requirements to participate. Prerequisites must be met for some individual courses. Minimum Eligibility Requirements

- Students must be in 11th or 12th grade
- 3.0 cumulative high school GPA required
- 10th graders with a 3.0 cumulative high school GPA may participate in **Dual Credit** courses with counselor approval.
- Must be 16 years old by the first day of class to take courses on a CEI campus or CEI online.

Per course, proof of **at least one** of the prerequisite options below must be completed and submitted to the CEI Early College Office along with a Registration Request Form.

Early College Programs Prerequisite Submission Guidelines

DEADLINES APPLY

How to turn in prerequisites:

Unofficial: Signature and seal not required. Printout from student account is acceptable and must include students full name.

Official: Submitted in an envelope signed and sealed by the issuer or delivered electronically from the account source.
(for example: AP scores must be sent directly from College Board to CEI)

Placement Exams

Unofficial transcripts are accepted for proof of ACT or SAT scores if recorded on a high school transcript. The transcript showing qualifying scores should be submitted along with registration form. Students may also submit an unofficial copy of their score sheet from an ACT, SAT, ALEKS or ACCUPLACER. Students can also request scores to be sent automatically to CEI when they sign up for an ACT or SAT.

AP Exams

Official transcripts are required for prior AP results. Students must request AP scores directly from collegeboard.org. Students can make this request for free when they sign up for an AP exam or they can pay to have scores sent after the results are released. Allow 4-6 weeks for scores to be reported.

Prior Coursework

Unofficial transcripts are accepted. Transcript must show the term/year the course was taken and the final grade. For prior college coursework, the unofficial transcript must also include the name of the institution where the course was completed and identifying information for the student.
