

1098-T Information

The 1098-T Tuition Statement is provided annually to each student who paid qualified tuition and related expenses during the previous year. It includes financial information such as tuition charges, scholarships received, and payments made. You, or the person who can claim you as a dependent, may need this information for either education credits or a tuition deduction on federal tax returns. The data on the form is also sent to the IRS. Learn more by reading <u>IRS Publication 970</u>.

To comply with federal laws, CEI is required to ask for your Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN). Your 1098-T form will be incomplete unless we have your social security number on file.

If you have not done so already, please provide your Social Security Number to the Registrar's Office by December 31st to ensure your information has been updated prior to the issuance of your 1098-T. Bring a valid ID and social security card to the Registrar's office to submit your SSN.

If you refuse to provide your SSN or ITIN, or you provide an incorrect number, the IRS is empowered to impose penalties. Note: Institutions are not required to report the demographic and financial data for students with nonresident alien status during the reporting year.

If you are eligible to receive a 1098-T, you can expect it to be available by January 31st. In Student <u>Self-Service</u>, you can make the choice to opt in to receive an electronic copy of your 1098-T. You will receive an email notification when it is ready, and then you will have the ability to securely view and/or print your form online immediately. If you do not consent to receive an electronic copy of your 1098-T, a paper copy will be mailed to your address on record.

Electronic Forms-Recommended

- Log into CEI Student <u>Self-Service</u>. If you need help logging into your account, contact the Help Desk at (208)535-5444.
- Click on 'Tax Information' and consent to receive the 1098-T in electronic format to view any available forms.
- Select the tax year you would like to view.
- When the PDF opens, save, or print the document.

Mailing of Forms-Make sure your mailing address is current.

- If you do not consent to electronic format of tax information, you will be mailed a 1098-T in paper format to the mailing address on file at CEI.
