### **Where can I find my immunization record?**

- Doctor's office or clinic that administered the immunizations
- School Records
- Your district's Public Health Department

### **Where can I get a TB test done?**

- Community or Urgent Care facilities
- Doctor's offices
- Your district's Public Health Department

### **How do I get my background check done?**

- The background checks are conducted by PreCheck, Inc., a firm specializing in background checks for healthcare workers.
  - Your order must be placed online through <https://www.precheck.com/students>
  - Cost is \$51.50
  - A background check typically takes 3-5 business days to complete.

### **How do I get my Healthcare Provider CPR training?**

- Healthcare Provider BLS through the American Heart Association training can be located on our website at <https://ceiworkforce.augusoft.net/>. Select Browse>>Select All Classes>>Scroll down to Healthcare Careers >> CPR/First Aid>>Healthcare Provider CPR
- The cost is \$95.00 and the certification is good for two years.
