CNA - FAQ Sheet

Where can I find my immunization record?

- Doctor's office or clinic that administered the immunizations, school records, your district's Public Health Department
- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention provides information regarding lost or missing immunization records at:

Where can I get a Quantitative Gold blood test done?

- Community or Urgent Care facilities, doctor's offices, or your district's Public Health Department

How do I get my background check done?

- The background checks are conducted by PreCheck, Inc., a firm specializing in background checks for healthcare workers.
 - Your order must be placed online through <https://www.precheck.com/students>
 - Cost is \$51.50*
 - A background check typically takes 3-5 business days to complete.

How do I get my Healthcare Provider CPR training?

- Healthcare Provider BLS through the American Heart Association training can be located on our website at <https://ceiworkforce.augusoft.net/>. Select Browse>>Select All Classes>>Scroll down to Healthcare Careers >> CPR/First Aid>>BLS for Healthcare Providers
- The cost is \$95.00* and the certification is good for two years.

Is attending an Orientation required?

- Yes – Anyone that does not attend the Mandatory Orientation will not be allowed to register for the class.
