



## Certified Nursing Assistant Training

Begin a career in health care as a Certified Nursing Assistant. You will be trained to immediately enter the workforce and provide hands-on, personal care in numerous settings, including hospitals, long-term care and assisted living facilities, home health and hospice. The class components include lectures, assignments, class skills practice, and clinical experience at local healthcare facilities. Successful completion provides eligibility to take the state exams required for placement on the Idaho Nurse Aide registry. These exams are offered at CEI.

### Prerequisites:

Once ALL of the below items have been completed, they will need to be submitted in order to register.

- Attend a Mandatory Orientation
- Clear Background Check (see information below)
- American Heart Association or American Red Cross BLS CPR Certification
- Negative TB test/PPD
- Hepatitis B Series (Minimum 1 of 3 started)
- Flu shot (*Required during flu season October - April*)
- COVID Vaccination (Required for clinicals)

### Additional Requirements:

- **Background check:** Please go to StudentCheck to order your background check: <https://candidate.precheck.com/StudentCheck?schoolId=14034>. This is the **only** background check accepted for this program and it must be fully processed before class registration is allowed. It must be current within the last year, not to expire during the class session. The **cost** is \$51.50 and is payable online when ordering.
  - Individuals who have been convicted of a felony within the past seven years will not be admitted to the CNA program. Convictions greater than seven years will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis in accordance with clinical site policy.
  - Individuals who have been convicted of a misdemeanor related to but not limited to battery, assault, substance/alcohol abuse, or theft within the last three years will not be admitted to the CNA program. Any other misdemeanor convictions greater than three years will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis taking into consideration the type of misdemeanor and repeated offenses.

- **Textbooks:** *Nursing Assisting: A Foundation in Caregiving 5<sup>th</sup> Edition* and the state skills packet are included in the cost of the class and available to pick up at the CEI bookstore **with your receipt.**
- **2 Piece Blood Pressure kit (separate Sphygmomanometer and Stethoscope)** also available at the CEI bookstore.
- **Scrubs:** 1 – 2 sets of scrubs. No white scrubs and no logos. Must be worn to class starting 1st day with closed toe, comfortable walking shoes.
- **Wristwatch:** with a sweeping second hand.
- **Small notebook** and a black pen for clinical.
  
- **Immunizations:**
  - **TB or PPD test:** This is to check for tuberculosis. If you've had this completed within a year prior to the completion date of the class, you just need to provide the documentation. Otherwise, you will need to get this test done.
  - **Hepatitis B vaccine:** At least the first one of three vaccines in the series must be completed prior to registration.
  - **Influenza (flu) vaccine:** Required during October 1<sup>st</sup>-April 1<sup>st</sup>. Influenza in the elderly can be deadly. Our goal is to prevent death and illness in the vulnerable people we care for during clinicals. If a student chooses not to obtain the influenza vaccine, a mask may be required to be worn at clinicals.
  - **COVID vaccine:** the COVID vaccine is Required to attend clinicals.

**Skills and Written Exam:** Students may re-test if they do not pass the first time; each additional test will require registration and payment.
