Begin a career in health care as a Certified Nursing Assistant. You will be trained to immediately enter the workforce and provide hands-on, personal care in numerous settings, including hospitals, long-term care and assisted living facilities, home health and hospice. The class components include online assignments, class skills practice, and clinical experience at local healthcare facilities. Successful completion provides eligibility to take the state exams required for placement on the Idaho Nurse Aide registry. These exams are offered at CEI.

Prerequisites:

Once ALL of the below items have been completed, you will be eligible to register.

- ___ Attend a Mandatory Orientation
- ___ Clear Background Check
 - Please go to StudentCheck to order your background check:
<https://candidate.precheck.com/StudentCheck?schoolId=14034>. This is the **only** background check accepted for this program and it must be fully processed before class registration is allowed. It must be current within the last year, not to expire during the class session. The **cost** is \$51.50 and is payable online when ordering
- ___ Healthcare Provider BLS CPR Certificate
 - All students are required to have Basic Life Support (CPR) certification through the American Heart Association prior to registration and start of class. No online CPR cards are valid for this class. Certification will only be accepted from the American Heart Association; no others will be accepted.
- ___ Quantitative Gold blood testing to evaluate for TB
- ___ Flu vaccine during flu season (October – March)
- ___ COVID Immunization Series
- ___ Hepatitis B Immunization Series and/or proof of positive titer to check for immunity - if negative, booster is required with repeat titer 1 month later
- ___ MMR vaccine or positive titer to all 3 components (measles, mumps, rubella)
- ___ Varicella vaccine or positive titer
- ___ Tdap within 10 years time

Additional requirements once enrolled in order to go to the hospital clinical rotation (These are optional and arrangements will be made once enrolled in the course)

- 10 panel drug urine test or higher
- N95 mask fitting
- IFCH/MVH booklet completion
