



## 2024-2025 Course Prerequisites

## How to submit prerequisites:

Unofficial: Unofficial transcripts can be used for placement into classes. Signature and seal not required. A printout from a student account of the credit source is acceptable and must include the name of the institution, student full name, and final grade or score. i.e. If prerequisite course was taken from a college other than CEI, the student must submit an unofficial transcript sourced directly from that college account. If using exam scores to place into a class, students can submit a printout from the account source or a high school transcript if their school records exam score information on transcripts.

Official: Submitted in an envelope signed and sealed by the issuer or delivered electronically from the account source. Official transcripts must be received and evaluated for CEI to grant credit.
