

## Part-Time (PT) Program Application Checklist

- Be accepted as a student in good standing at College of Eastern Idaho
  - You must be a current student at CEI at least 2 weeks prior to first day of application period to be eligible to apply to nursing program.
- Provide documentation of a current, non-encumbered CNA certification (full-time or part time options) or a current LPN license (Bridge option)
- Complete all prerequisite courses with a 77% (C+) or higher and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Prerequisite courses include:
  - [MICR 111 - Introduction to Microbiology](#) 3 Credits and
  - [MICR 111L - Introduction to Microbiology Laboratory](#) 1 Credits
  - [ENGL 101 - Writing & Rhetoric I](#) 3 Credits
  - [ENGL 102 - Writing & Rhetoric II](#) 3 Credits
  - [BIOL 227 - Human Anatomy & Physiology I](#) 4 Credits and
  - [BIOL 227L - Human Anatomy & Physiology I Lab](#) 0 Credits
  - [BIOL 228 - Human Anatomy & Physiology II](#) 4 Credits and
  - [BIOL 228L - Human Anatomy & Physiology II Lab](#) 0 Credits
  - [COMM 101 - Fundamentals of Oral Communication](#) 3 Credits
  - Complete one of the following two:
    - Math 153 is recommended for those students who plan on going into the RN program and then pursuing a bachelor's degree.
    - [MATH 143 - College Algebra](#) 3 Credits **OR**
    - [MATH 153 - Statistical Reasoning](#) 3 Credits
  - Complete one of the following two:
    - [PSYC 101 - Introduction to Psychology](#) 3 Credits **OR**
    - [SOC 101 - Introduction to Sociology](#) 3 Credits
  - Complete one of the following two:
    - [ENGL 175 - Literature & Ideas](#) 3 Credits **or**
    - Equivalent Humanities Course 3 Credits
- Be at least 18 years old at the start of the program
- Have TEAS test score of 62% or higher
  - TEAS exam may be taken a maximum of two (2) times per semester. If a second attempt is necessary, it must be taken within two (2) years of the first attempt. The score is good for **five (5) years.**
  - The TEAS exam is offered at the CEI testing center. Contact the testing center directly at (208) 535-5438 to schedule a time to take the exam.
  - Fees for the TEAS are \$30.00 for the proctoring fee and \$70.00 for the test for a total of \$100.00. The proctoring fee needs to be paid in the Business Office in the Christofferson Building # 3. The fee for the test will be paid online to ATI prior to taking the test with a credit or debit card.
  - You must provide the proctor with the receipt of payment from the Business Office and a photo ID at the time of testing.

- An SAT score of 1100 or ACT score of 22 may be used in lieu of the TEAS exam if taken within five (5) years.
